Flowing Wells High School is located in Tucson's Northwest area in the Flowing Wells District. FWHS was established in 1954 and graduated its first class in 1956 of 5 students. Over 50% of the FWHS faculty and administration hold advanced degrees.

SCHOOL CALENDAR

The FWHS academic year is divided into two semesters with official grades reported in late December and in late May. Students are on a traditional schedule consisting of 55 minute periods.

CREDITS & GRADUATION

A minimum of 22 credits are required to receive a high school diploma and 23 credits for a gold advanced diploma. One-half credit is awarded for each semester-long course which is completed with a passing mark of at least a 60%. While the majority of students elect to take four years of solid academic courses, the minimum distribution of credits for a FWHS Diploma for the class of 2015 must include:
