

Real Time Remote Learning: Parent's Guide

1. When do classes begin?

School begins Thursday, August 6th. All students will follow the Daily Class Schedule from home, which means during their first hour they will log in and connect with their first hour teacher and classmates.

2. How will my student know how to log in or begin each class?

Teachers will invite students to their google classroom and/or Zoom experience through the students' assigned -fwusd8 google email. Students who are new to the high school or students who have forgotten their passwords for this email account are encouraged to call Ms. Zapian at 696-8108 for assistance, preferably prior to August 6th.

3. Does my student have to attend all scheduled classes?

Yes. In real time remote learning, students are in class during their scheduled class time to connect with teachers and receive instruction. Students are encouraged to be on time for all classes because during the period teachers may allow students to log off the virtual environment so that they may work on their assignment for the day.

4. How can I tell if my student is logging in and/or doing the work?

- a. PowerSchool will track class grades and attendance. If a student is marked absent from a class, the student did not log in during class. If a zero is recorded in PowerSchool, the student did not complete the work.
- b. Parents may email teachers to ask to be added as a parent in the Google Classroom platform. (ex: Rebecca.Hurst@fwusd.org)

5. How can my student get help without physically being on campus?

Students should be punctual as they follow the bell schedule to connect with the teacher and classmates. When the teacher is not giving direct instruction, he/she/they are available during the entire class time and during the planning period via phone or email. Also, additional learning aides will be made available in Google Classroom.
